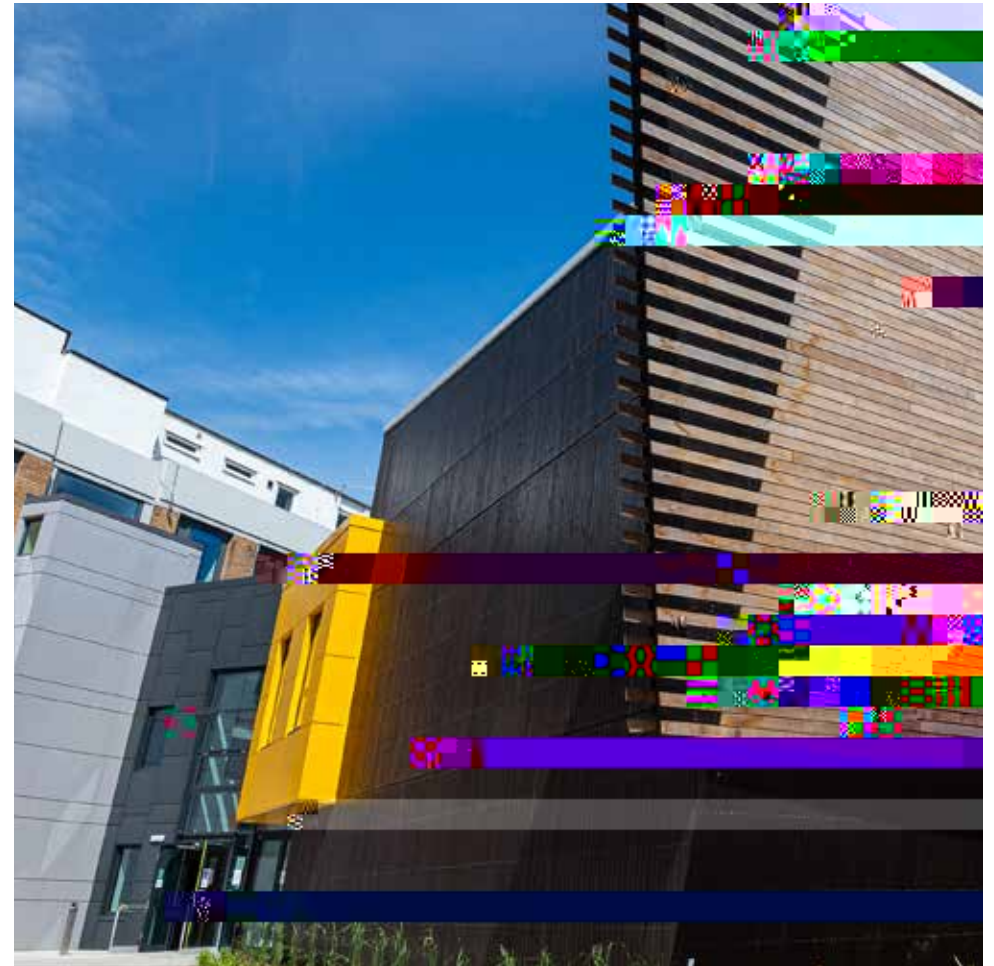




Health Innovation Campus

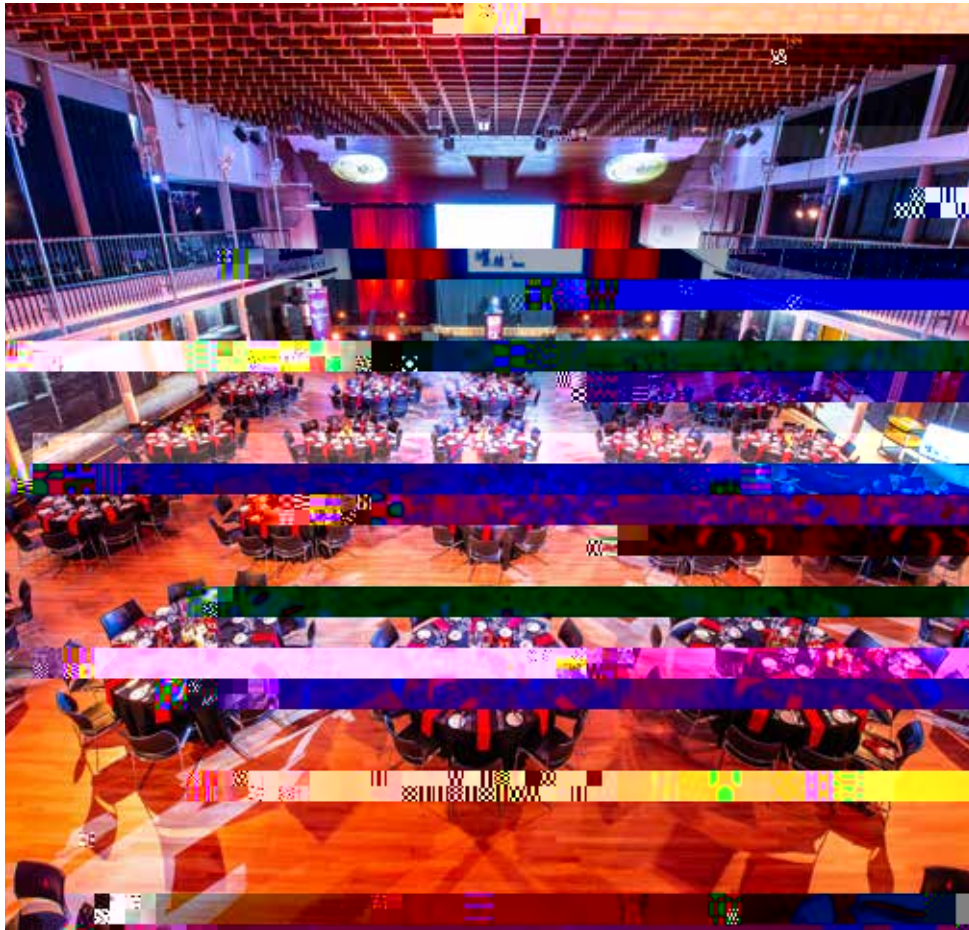

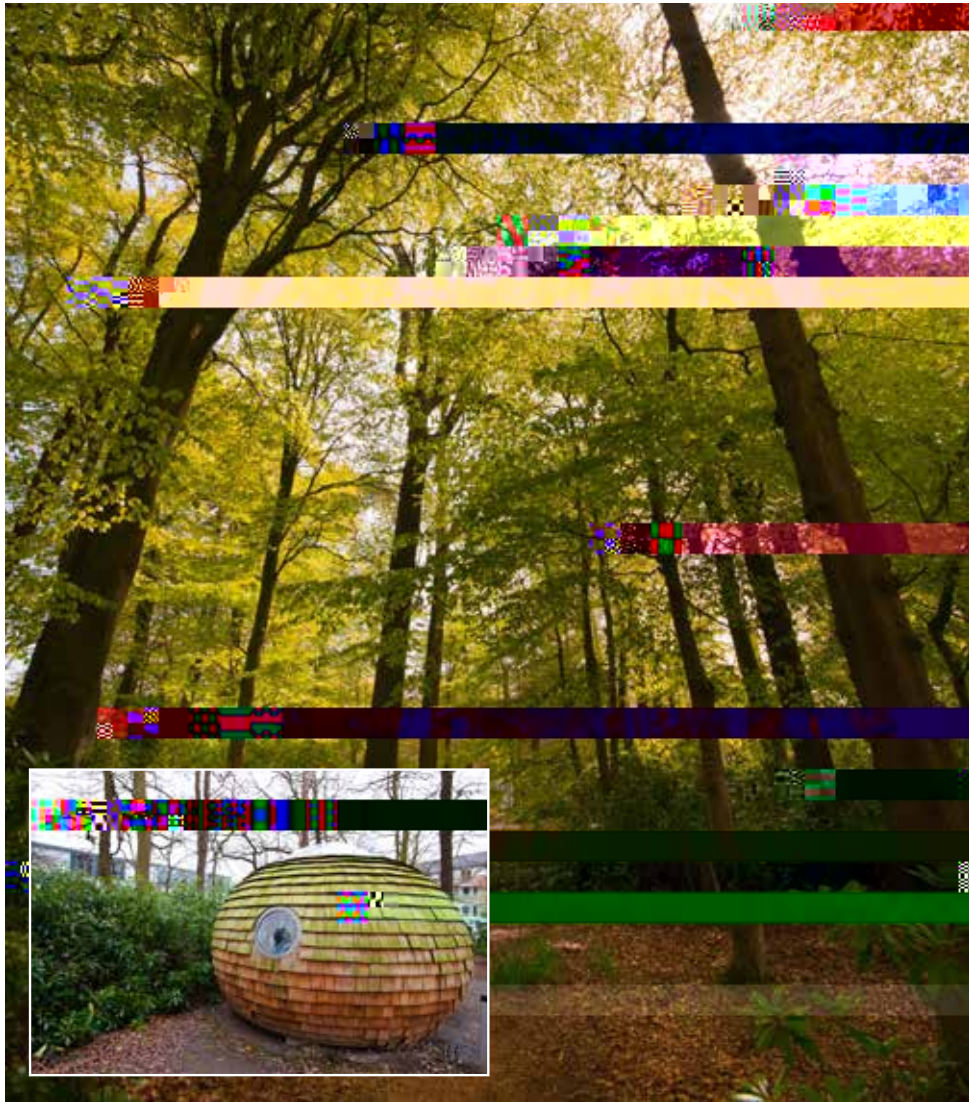

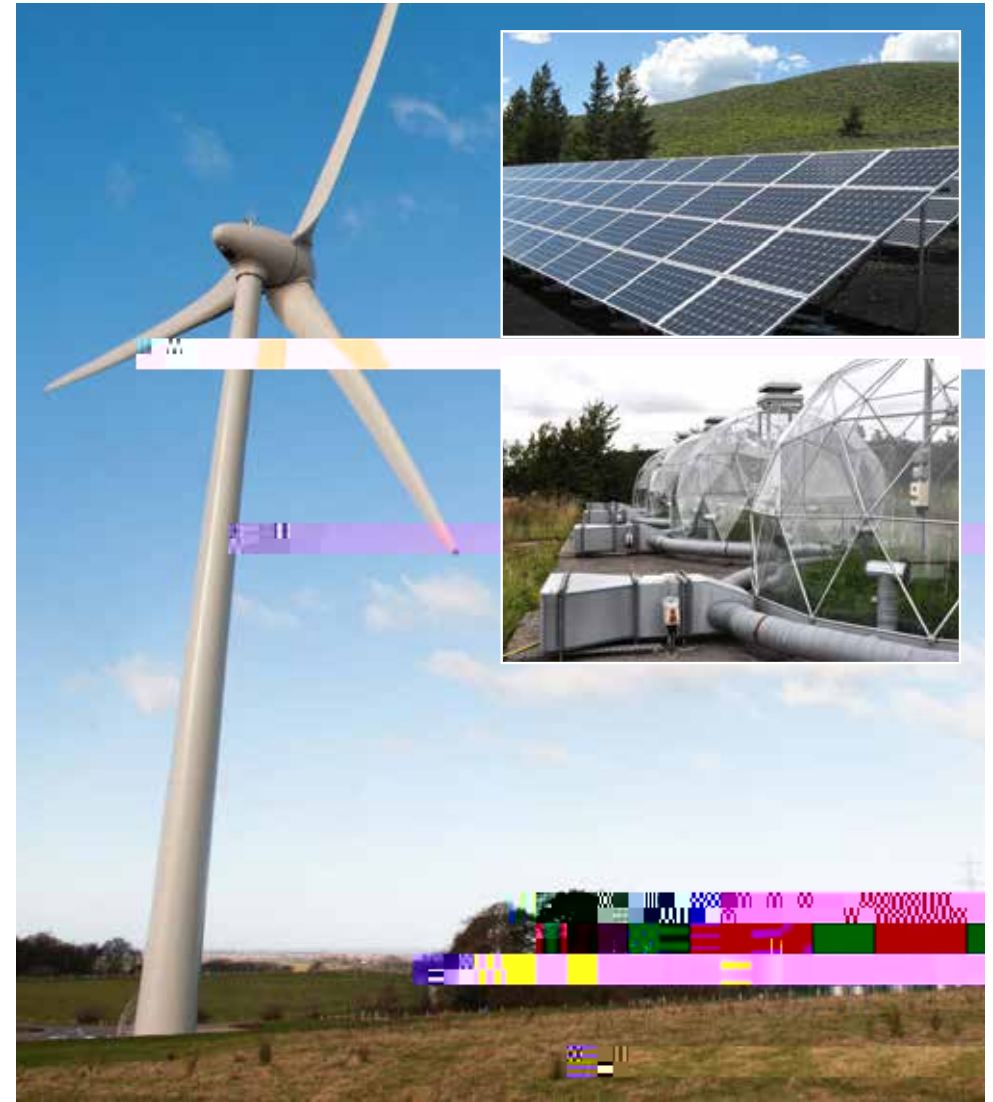
