Brings together world leaders, negotiators, government representatives, businesses and citizens for 12 days of talks



What is this COP about?



COP21 delivered the Paris Agreement

First time all nations came together and made a legally binding agreement to limit global warming to below 2 degrees and preferably 1.5 degrees Celsius, compared to pre-industrial levels.





Why is it important to go for 1.5 C?

We have experienced about 1.1 C degrees of warming so far

Increase in intense rainfalls and droughts, extreme heatwaves, are attributable to climate change


+1.5 C world has fewer extremes compared to a +2 C world

We also reduce the risk of biodiversity loss and crossing tipping points not stray too far into the unknown








